# Framing a research question



## Start with the 'what'

- What problems are most salient about my teaching situation?
- What was my role/which action did I take then?
- What might happen if I changed something in my teaching situation?

## How can I improve my practice?

- I would like to improve ...
- I want to change ...
- I am perplexed by / concerned or worried about ...
- I think ... would really make a difference to ...
- I am particularly interested in ...

## Narrow the focus

Research questions beginning with **what**, **why** or **how** are usually broader and get at explanations, relationships, and reasons.
